## The Americans with Disabilities Act

Changing demographics of people with mobility disabilities, obesity and the average age of patients on the rise, and the high percentage of healthcare worker injuries requires newly designed products to meet the changing needs.

Recently, the Department of Justice ("DOJ") issued a final rule implementing title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA"). The DOJ, the enforcing authority for ADA regulations, adopted the Access Board's 2017 ADA standards.<sup>1</sup> The DOJ's ruling mandates that medical and dental offices, clinics, emergency rooms, hospitals, and other healthcare settings must ensure that at least one, and up to 10%–20%, of their Medical Diagnostic Equipment ("MDE") complies with the 2017 ADA standards.

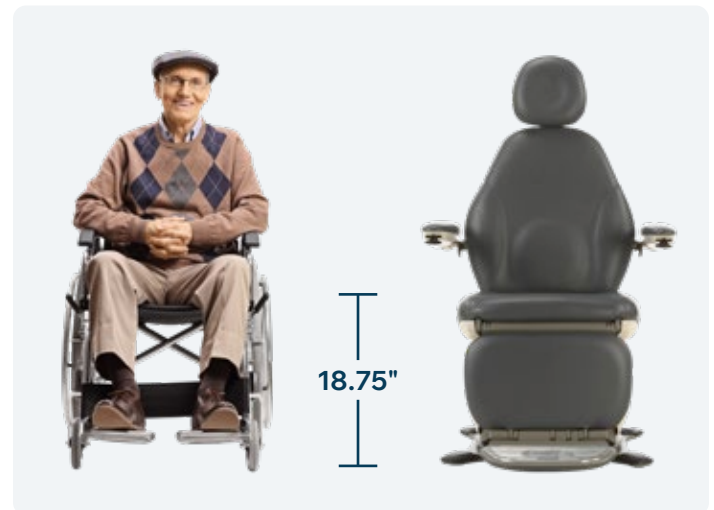
MTI's ADA compliant chairs are among the only chairs that address our changing healthcare demographics and fully comply with ADA regulations. Key components of this regulation include an entry height of 17–19 inches, a 21 inch seat width, and a patient transfer support.

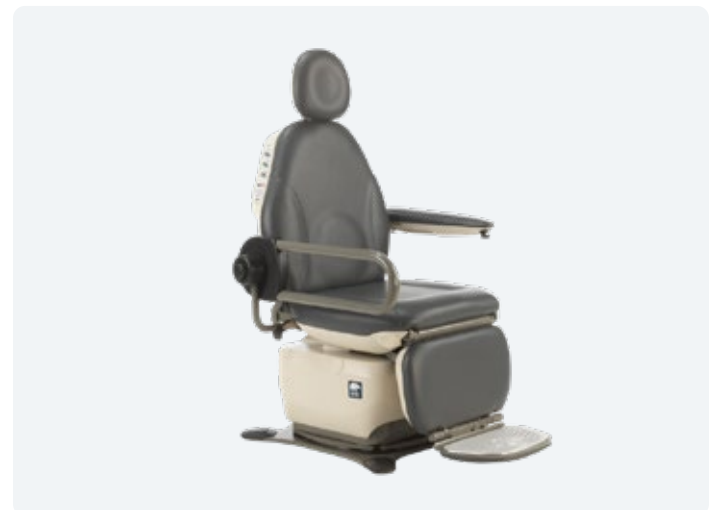

## ComfortSync™

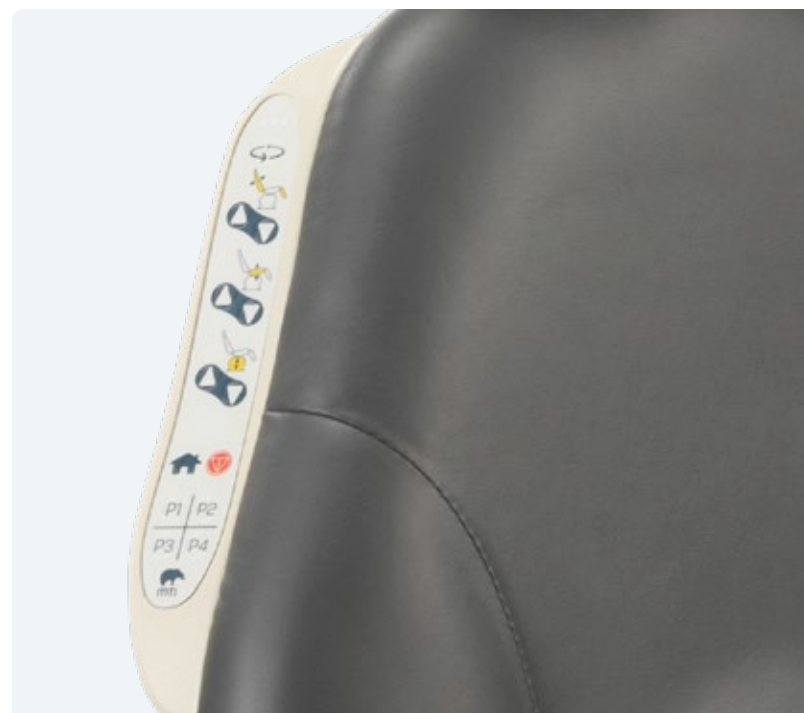

ComfortSync™ provides independent, smooth movements of the leg rest and footrest as it follows the natural relationship of the patient's resting legs and feet by automatically extending and maintaining that relationship until just before the chair reaches the flat position. The leg rest also extends automatically to compensate for taller patients.

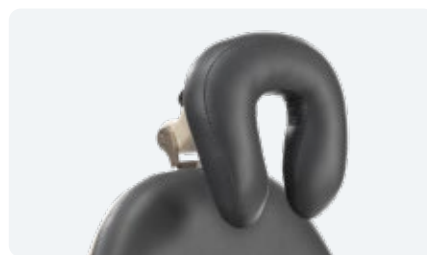
